

Code of Ethics for Timmins Construction Association

Honesty and Integrity: Timmins Construction Association promotes its members to serve its customers and their competitors, subcontractors and suppliers with honesty and integrity.

Employees: Timmins Construction Association promotes its members to comply with the letter and spirit of laws relating to working conditions. Our members should not knowingly violate any law or regulation dealing with employment standards.

Safety: Timmins Construction Association promotes its members to assure that the safety of its employees, the employees of others on the job site and the general public at large is given the highest priority in all aspects of the firm's activities.

Standards of Practice: Timmins Construction Association promotes its members to utilize materials and services in a manner consistent with the established and accepted standards of the construction industry and with the laws and regulations. Including the use of standard industry documents where feasible.

Image of the Construction Industry: Timmins Construction Association asks its members to uphold the standards of the construction industry with honour and dignity.

Competition: Timmins Construction Association promotes its members to compete fairly for contracts, avoiding any practice that might be construed to be in violation of the letter or spirit of federal or provincial competition or unfair business practices legislation.
